





ABBREVIATIONS (US)

R: row

Sc: Single crochet

Ch: Chain

Dec: Decrease (2 stitches together by the front loop for invisible

decrease)

Sts: Stitches

Tog: together (stitches together by the front loop for invisible

decrease)

(...) x: Repeat stitches within parentheses ... times

[]: number between squared crochet gives the total number

of stitches of the row

Color change from blue to white

To start the white, the sc before the white stitch: yarn over and pull with blue, then yarn over and pull with white.

For the last white stitch, just finish it completely with white and start the next stitch in blue (this ensures symmetric white on right and left side).

Arms (x2) – With blue yarn

- → R1 6 st in magic loop
- \rightarrow R2 (2 sc, 1 inc) x3
- R3 R4 8 sc (finish row 5 with a slip stitch)

Legs (x2) – With blue yarn

- → R1 6 st in magic loop
- \rightarrow R2 (1 sc, 1 inc) x3
- → R3 R5 9 sc (finish row 5 with a slip stitch, except for the second leg) On the second leg, do not cut the string, continue with the body

Body – With blue yarn

- → R6 (join the 2 legs) 4 sc on the first leg, 5 ch, 9 sc on the second leg, 5 sc on the ch, 5 sc [28 st]
- → R7 R8 28 sc
- → R9 2 dec, 6 sc white, 4 dec blue, 6 sc white, 2 dec blue [20 st]
- → R10 20 sc white
- → R11 R14 20 sc blue
- → Stuff the legs
- → R15 (join the 2 arms) 8 sc on the first arm, 3 blue sc, 4 white sc, 3 blue sc, 8 sc on the second arm, 3 blue sc, 4 white sc, 3 blue sc [36]
- → R16 11 blue sc, 5 white sc, 14 blue sc, 5 white sc, 3 blue sc [36]
- → R17 3 blue sc ,4 st tog x2 with blue, 6 white sc, 4 st tog x3, 6 white sc, 4 st tog blue [18]
- → R18 18 sc white
- → R19 18 sc blue
- → R20 18 sc blue
- → R21 (1 sc, 1 dec) x6 [12]
- → Stuff the arms (lightly) and the body
- → R22 6 dim [6]
- → Fasten off and leave a long tail to sew around the white part of the head and give the shape.
